ACCCA Board Approves Changes to Strategic Plan for 2020-21

Last Friday the ACCCA Board of Directors took action to incorporate updated tactics into its rolling five-year [Strategic Plan](#) to improve the structure and fiscal vitality of the association so ACCCA can quickly respond to our member's needs throughout this challenging time.

In a unanimous vote, the members of the board, representing all key areas of management, endorsed the work of the four strategic teams charged with applying the feedback from the 2020 member survey to the goals and objectives that will drive funding and activities for the Association this year.

Here are just a few of the highlights of the revised plan already underway:

- *Significantly reducing operating overhead. By increasing efficiencies, reducing the size of the office and allowing some remote work ACCCA's administration will be able to accomplish more with a smaller investment.*
- *Development of standards of practice for increasing recognition of administrative rights.*
- *Increasing access to training and development by expanding online options and establishing a new program directed at aspiring administrators.*

As you know, the majority of the work necessary to accomplish these objectives is done by an army of dedicated ACCCA members who are our volunteers. 2020-21 Legislative Platform Approved by Board

Also at last Friday's meeting, the Board took action to approve the [2020-21 Legislative Platform](#). The revised platform includes updated statements on community college finance, health and safety of students, staff and faculty and it re-states our official advocating position on diversity, equity and inclusion issues in the California Community Colleges. A separate *Statement of Equity* that specifically outlines the Association's commitment to DEI will be distributed once a final version is approved by the Board.
