Consider this...ACCJC reviews (and when needed, revises) its Accreditation Standards every 10 years, in accordance with the Policy on Review of Accreditation Standards and right now they're building a collaborative and transparent process by working with **professionals from the field** as the 2025 Standards are drafted.

Today they launched their Standards Review website, and officially began accepting applications for Peer Writing and Peer Reading team members who will work in partnership with ACCJC staff to develop the draft Standards that will be presented to the field for feedback. Applications are being accepted through March 1, 2021 and successful candidates will be selected to reflect the professional, institutional, geographic, and demographic diversity of ACCJC's membership. 






EQUITY AVENGERS:
