


MONDAY MOTIVATION

Together with the Sierra Sacramento Valley Medical Society, they teamed up with students and faculty from Sierra College to churn out the much needed face shields needed by medical personnel.

The Sierra College response is coordinated by <u>Amy Schultz</u>, Dean of Career, Continuing, & Technical Education.
