and our panel was exceptional in their detail. **Keith Curry**, President/CEO at Compton College; **Cynthia Olivo**, Vice President of Student Services at Pasadena City College and **Scott Conrad**, Interim Dean of Education Services and Technology at MiraCosta College shared lots of insights, resources and lessons learned the hard way about serving students in this pandemic.

This webinar highlighted the innovative ways our leaders across the system are continuously finding ways to meet the needs of students, faculty, staff and communities that rely so heavily on our colleges. In response to the pandemic, the CollegeBuys and Collaborative Services team under the Foundation for California Community Colleges has partnered with local districts to vet and negotiate system-wide contracts for a wide array of products and services. Pooling our community college system's resources together, the Foundation's contracts strive to obtain best pricing and best value for all our institutions. As of today, there are over 100+ system-wide contracts already available for our 115 colleges to use. A couple of Foundation resources highlighted in the webinar included discounted hot spots through the [California Connects Program](#) and the newly added GrubHub partnership agreement for distributing food vouchers.
